First and foremost, congratulations on your recent election as Chairman of the Ways and Means Committee for the remainder of the 114th Congress. We look forward to working with you and assisting you in any way as you head this historic committee.

As supporters of fundamental tax reform, we urge you to work with members of this chamber in order to place an overhaul of America's tax code on the President's desk. We hope that you will allow a full and open process where all members have a chance to offer their ideas. As such, we urge full consideration of H.R. 25, the FairTax Act of 2015, which would replace all federal taxes on income with a single national retail sales tax. If enacted, studies show that an additional \$450 billion in revenues would be generated over a 10-year period – not by raising taxes, but by economic growth and investment. This is a measure that our constituents fully support. As members of the People's House we believe it is in the best interest of debate for this proposal to see full consideration.
